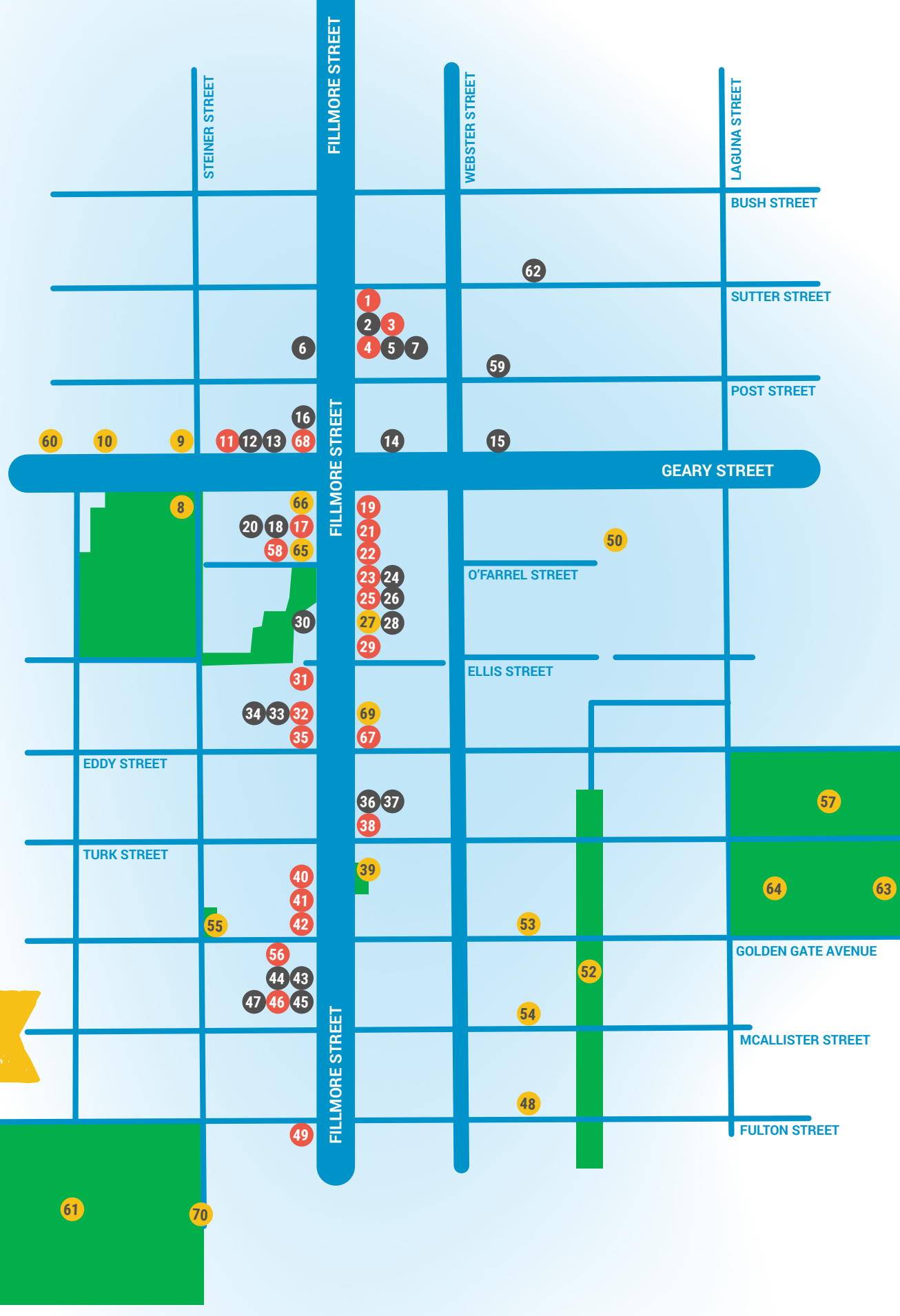

Once known as San Francisco's "new downtown," and the "Harlem of the West," the Fillmore district today represents San Francisco's cultural diversity, has some of the City's best food and nightlife, and is a hub for arts and culture. From world-famous parks and architecture to historic music venues, Fillmore is a popular destination for tourists and locals alike.

The lively Fillmore district is connected to public transit lines across San Francisco, with the 22-Fillmore running the entire length of the corridor. The following bus lines also service the area:

HISTORY HIGHLIGHTS

As the fires from the 1906 earthquake engulfed downtown, merchants and citizens migrated to the untouched Fillmore to continue doing business. Even after merchants moved back to Market Street, Fillmore Street remained a vibrant and bustling commercial corridor.

During World War II, the combination of forced Japanese internment and the influx of African Americans seeking jobs in wartime industries dramatically changed the demographics of the neighborhood.

The burgeoning African American community supported new jazz clubs as the neighborhood flourished with black-owned businesses; the district was dubbed 'the Harlem of the West'.

One of the most influential figures of this period was African American businessman Charles Sullivan, known at the time as the Mayor of Fillmore. He owned and operated several music venues in the area, including the Fillmore Auditorium, and was one of the most successful music promoters on the West Coast.

During the post WWII period, the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency displaced thousands of residents and small businesses, severely damaging the community fabric.

The historic Fillmore Auditorium, made famous by Bill Graham during the 1960s counter culture revolution remains one of the most famous music venues in the Bay Area and beyond.
