

Open Streets Ambassador

Position Overview

Livable City is hiring multiple Open Streets Ambassadors to help support street closure and COVID-19 compliance at sites across San Francisco.

These are part-time, seasonal positions, paying \$20/hour for approximately 16-24 hours per week for approximately 12-16 weeks with mandatory attendance at all scheduled activations within the contract period.

Responsibilities Include

- Set up and break down barricades and other traffic control devices
- Move barricades and assist clearing the roadway for emergency vehicles
- Facilitate local access for Paratransit, residents with off-street parking, and/or scheduled commercial deliveries
- Monitor barricades at designated post to ensure proper placement throughout the street activation
- Assist with mask wearing and social distancing enforcement
- Provide event and detour information to participants and drivers

Requirements

Essential:

- Regular availability Friday Sunday, both daytime and evening
- Ability to do physically demanding work; ability to stand for 6-10 hours and lift 25 lbs
- Self-motivated with an ability to work independently and in teams
- Punctual, trustworthy and reliable
- Ability to work effectively with a wide variety of individuals, including staff, vendors, exhibitors, and members of the public

Highly Desired:

- Experience with event production and management
- A commitment to Livable City's mission and values
- Bilingual (Spanish, Tagalog, and Cantonese preferred)
