



Sunday Streets Route Manager

Livable City is San Francisco's urban land use policy and advocacy nonprofit. The organization works to create a San Francisco of great streets and complete neighborhoods, where walking, bicycling, and transit are the best choices for most trips, where public spaces are beautiful, well-designed, and well-maintained, and where housing is more plentiful and more affordable.

Livable City also runs a number of programs, including Sunday Streets and Play Streets. These programs bring communities together, promoting healthy living and active transportation to create vibrant, healthy, connected communities across the city through the format of car-free streets.

Livable City has six dedicated full-time staff, augmented by passionate interns and hundreds of annual volunteers.

Position Overview

Livable City is seeking to fill several Route Managers positions to support event production at Sunday Streets Phoenix Day on October 17th, 2021.

This is a contract position to engage non-exempt employees for the production of Sunday Streets Phoenix Day with required attendance at training sessions and event day.

The Route Manager position pays \$22.50/hour with a projected contract total of ~\$400.

Event Production Responsibilities

- Lead event-day route setup and breakdown plans
- Ensure barricades and signage are properly setup; ensure street closure remains secure throughout the day
- Manage and support setup/breakdown and barricade monitor volunteers
- Work with the Logistics Manager and City personnel to ensure a safe and efficient street opening and closing

Requirements

- Ability to attend all training sessions and Sunday Streets Phoenix Day (schedule listed below)
- Has their own bike; comfortable riding bike on city streets with vehicle
- Capable of physically demanding work; ability to stand for more than 4 hours and lift 50 lbs
- Experience in event production (1 year minimum)
- Proven experience leading teams
- Self-motivated with an ability to work independently and in teams
- Ability to work effectively with a wide variety of individuals, including volunteers, staff, partners, and members of the public

Highly Desired

- Familiarity with the goals and vision of Sunday Streets
- Bilingual (particularly Spanish, Tagalog or Cantonese)
- A resident of one of the following neighborhoods: Mission, Excelsior, Tenderloin, Bayview/Hunters Point, Mission Bay, Dogpatch, SoMa, Western Addition, and Sunset
