



Sunday Streets Volunteer Manager

Livable City is San Francisco's urban land use policy and advocacy nonprofit. The organization works to create a San Francisco of great streets and complete neighborhoods, where walking, bicycling, and transit are the best choices for most trips, where public spaces are beautiful, well-designed, and well-maintained, and where housing is more plentiful and more affordable.

Livable City also runs a number of programs, including Sunday Streets and Play Streets. These programs bring communities together, promoting healthy living and active transportation to create vibrant, healthy, connected communities across the city through the format of car-free streets.

Livable City has six dedicated full-time staff, augmented by passionate interns and hundreds of annual volunteers.

Position Overview

Livable City is seeking to fill several Volunteer Managers positions to support event production at Sunday Streets Phoenix Day on October 17th, 2021.

This is a contract position to engage non-exempt employees for the production of Sunday Streets Phoenix Day with required attendance to at least 1 virtual and 1 in-person training sessions before event day.

The Volunteer Manager position pays \$22-25/hour DOE.

Event Production Responsibilities

- Oversee volunteer check-in and assignments
- Conduct onsite volunteer job and safety trainings
- Supervise and provide additional trainings to all volunteers as needed
- Work with Activity Hub and Event Volunteer Managers to setup information and check-in booth; ensure a tidy and responsive station throughout the day
- Answer questions regarding Sunday Streets
- Assist participants, volunteers, and exhibitors, as needed

Requirements

- Ability to attend all training sessions and Sunday Streets Phoenix Day (schedule listed below)
- Proven experience managing volunteers and leading teams
- Experience in event production (1 year minimum)
- Capable of physically demanding work; ability to stand for more than 4 hours and lift 50 lbs
- Friendly, customer-service attitude
- Ability to work effectively with a wide variety of individuals, including volunteers, staff, partners, and members of the public

Required Availability

All Phoenix Day staff must also be available between 7am-8pm on October 17th, 2021 and attend at 1 least virtual and one in-person training session before event day.
