
Sunday Streets SF 2022 *Insurance Requirements*

ABOUT

Sunday Streets is a program of the nonprofit Livable City, presented in partnership with SFMTA, SFDPH, and the City and County of San Francisco. Sunday Streets mission is to:

- Create temporary open space and recreational opportunities in neighborhoods most lacking
- Encourage active living and healthy eating
- Foster community building
- Inspire people to think differently about their streets as public spaces

This policy is part of Sunday Streets SF Program Guidelines, which were created to maintain public safety and the integrity of the program's mission. We thank you in advance for investing in San Francisco by participating at Sunday Streets SF and observing this policy along with all other policies as outlined in Sunday Streets Program Guidelines.

The following insurance documents are required for any exhibitor, sponsor, or organization wishing to do physical activities with participants during Sunday Streets.

1. Certificate of Insurance: Proof of Commercial General Liability insurance with limits not less than \$1,000,000 for each occurrence and \$2,000,000 general aggregate for bodily injury and property damage including contractual liability, personal injury, products and completed operations.
2. Certificate of Additional Insured: This insurance must also cover Sunday Streets representing agencies via Certificate of Additional Insured. The following entities must be listed on the Certificate. A copy of the Endorsement **MUST** be provided - a statement on the Certificate is not acceptable.
 - a. Additional Insured Language: Livable City, Sunday Streets and the City and County of San Francisco, its Officers, Agents and Employees
