



Sunday Streets SF 2023 *Insurance Requirements*

ABOUT

Sunday Streets is a program of the nonprofit Livable City, presented in partnership with SFMTA, SFDPH, and the City and County of San Francisco. Sunday Streets' mission is to:

- Create temporary open spaces and recreational opportunities where it's needed most
- Encourage healthy eating and active living
- Foster community-building
- Inspire people to think about their streets as public spaces

This policy is part of Sunday Streets SF Program Guidelines, created to maintain public safety and the integrity of the program's mission. We thank you in advance for investing in San Francisco by participating in Sunday Streets SF and observing this policy and all other policies outlined in Sunday Streets Program Guidelines.

The following insurance documents are required for any exhibitor, sponsor, or organization wishing to do physical activities with participants or sell food during Sunday Streets.

- Certificate of Insurance: Proof of Commercial General Liability insurance with limits not less than \$1,000,000 for each occurrence and \$2,000,000 general aggregate for bodily injury and property damage including contractual liability, personal injury, products and completed operations.
- Certificate of Additional Insured: The following entities must be endorsed and listed on the Certificate. A copy of the Endorsement MUST be provided - a statement on the Certificate is not acceptable.
 - a. **Additional Insured Language:** Livable City, Sunday Streets and the City and County of San Francisco, its Officers, Agents and Employees
